#### **COURSE WORK**

#### Greens

We have pencil tined to keep the surface open.

We have had to double cut to reduce the amount of leaf on the grass plant because of the growth due to the night temperatures.

We have treated the greens for disease

## **Approaches**

We cut and feed as needed.

#### Tees

These are cut as required and fed monthly

## **Fairways**

We are waiting for a rainy day so that we can treat the fairways for leather jackets. As soon as it rains we will be spraying

#### **Bunkers**

These have been edged and will be done again when needed.

## Rough

We are cutting the lush areas more often and at the moment doing a full cut every two weeks to keep the stalks down.

#### **Boundaries**

We have had a meeting with the husband and wife from the house on the 13<sup>th</sup> that complained about balls going into their garden.

I have had a meeting with Poole council about making the trees along the 13<sup>th</sup> a TPO and they are looking at it now. This would mean that any work carried out on the trees would have to go through planning

To get trees that would be large enough to block balls would be very expensive and would require a tree spade to be used

The large pine on 13<sup>th</sup> is going to be taken down on the 21<sup>st</sup> of august and a note has been put up in the club house to inform the members that the hole might be closed for the day.

When looking at where the net would go a birch tree was identified that would also have to come out and this will be an extra cost to the original quote..

## Irrigation

The irrigation survey is going to take place on Wednesday the 21<sup>st</sup> august.

This price could have gone up as they were quoted a while ago.

This cost is for the compressor, fittings and air tools required.

#### **VANDALISM**

Only one flag has been stolen this month.

I am getting CCTV sign made and these will be put up around the course to try and persuade the little darlings from messing about.

#### **5 YEAR IMPROVEMENT PLAN**

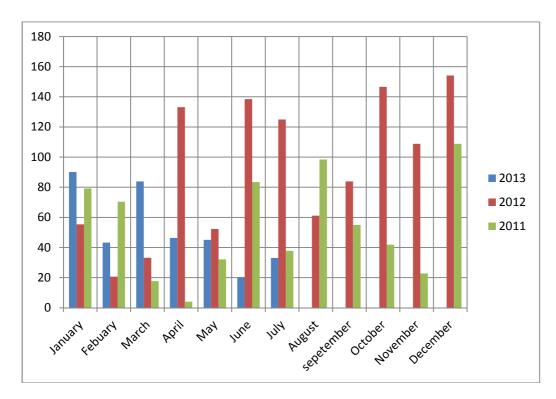
The quote for the design and construction has been sent in and because of the boundary issues these have been put on hold.
