	CH welcomed all to the first meeting of the new Committee. He reiterated that all decisions made were collective decisions and the Committee must show unity in communicating with members.

1558	MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING	
	The minutes of the meeting held on 7 October 2021, was tabled for discussion. On a show of hands, the majority of the Committee approved the minutes, and the captain was authorised to sign them as a true record.	
1559	MATTERS ARISING	
(a)	<u>Temporary Winter & 9 Hole Course Ratings</u> AW advised that he had discussed the <u>temporary winter tees</u> with IH, and he advised that mats must be placed be within 10 yards of the marker or within 100 yards of the overall length of the course. The current course set up with the winter mats would be within the 100 yards and therefore qualifying competitions could be played. The winter course was still to be measured and rated. This would be done at no cost to the club. It was also in the club remit to designate certain days of the week when qualifying scores could be submitted. AW advised that the <u>9-hole course</u> had been rated and loaded onto the handicap system. 9-hole competitions could therefore be played.	
(b)	<u>Course Record</u> AW – IH advised that it was very unusual to recognise a course record via a supplementary card. Clubs normal would only recognise a course record achieved in a qualifying competition. The Committee agreed to adopt the above principle.	
(c)	<u>Relief from Tree roots</u> Committee agreed to revise the local rules as below:	

	<p>"If a player's ball is in the general area and there is interference from exposed tree roots that are in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less or in the rough within four club-lengths of the edge of the ground cut to fairway height or less or in the first cut of the rough, the tree roots are treated as ground under repair. The player may take free relief under Rule 16.1b. But interference does not exist if the tree roots only interfere with the player's stance."</p> <p>AW to update local rule on scorecards when next order is placed.</p> <p>APA said that there were plans to raise the ground level to above the roots.</p>	AW

(b)	<p><u>Seniors – RP</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Match results: Bramshaw (A)- won 4-2 Came Down (A) – lost 2-4 Barton on Sea WL (H) – won 4½ -1½ Weymouth (A) won – 4 – 2 • KHKO cup won by Lyme Regis and plate by Dudsbury. A Groom was the organiser and M Randall the team captain. • Seniors Charity for 2021/22 would be Honeypot Children's Charity. • Seniors Championship would in future be drawn in handicap order. • Seniors committee would consider purchasing new lidded bins for the course to prevent the crows from reaching in. RB to forward quote. • Seniors committee believed that the Remembrance Day Charity competitions entry fee donation should be optional and not compulsory. RB said that Royal British Legion (RBL) provided each player with a ball marker and the winners with medals.
