| | AP confirmed that he continues to serve on the Management Committee and remains in the role of Chairman. He reported that the club has performed well financially this year and had no additional updates to present. | |

| (a) | <u>Ladies – CB / AC</u> | |
| | CB provided an update on recent interclub match results as follows: | |
