	<ul> <li>APA – local rule for relief from tree roots, could it be possibly changed to "general area".</li> <li><u>Current local rule:</u></li> <li>"If a player's ball is in the general area and there is interference from exposed tree roots that are in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less or in the rough within two club-lengths of the edge of the ground cut to fairway height or less or in the first cut of the rough, the tree roots are treated as ground under repair.
