## DRESS REGULATIONS

<b>COURSE</b>	<b>CLUBHOUSE</b>
<b>HEADGEAR</b>	<b>HEADGEAR</b>
Must be appropriate to golf and worn the correct way round.	<i>Headgear must be removed in the clubhouse.</i>
<b>SHIRTS</b>	<b>SHIRTS</b>
<p><i>Gentlemen - Must be designed for golf</i> and have a collar or turtle neck with long or short sleeves.</p> <p><b>Smart shirts</b> designed to be worn outside trousers &amp; shorts, are permitted</p> <p><i>Collarless and sleeveless shirts are NOT permitted</i></p> <p><i>Ladies - Smart golfing clothing is required at all times.</i> Collarless shirts and tailored sleeveless shirts designed specifically for golf may be worn.</p> <p><i>Tee shirts are NOT permitted.</i></p>	<p><i>Gentlemen - Smart shirts</i> designed to be worn outside trousers &amp; shorts, are permitted</p> <p><i>Gentlemen - Collarless and sleeveless shirts are NOT permitted</i></p> <p><i>Tee shirts are NOT permitted.</i></p>
<b>TROUSERS</b>	<b>TROUSERS</b>
<p><i>Gentlemen – Trousers must be tailored and ankle length, unless Plus 2's.</i></p> <p><i>Ladies - Trousers must be tailored, ankle or ¾ length only.</i></p> <p><i>Trousers must not be tucked into socks, with the exception of when they are covered by waterproof trousers.</i></p>	<p>Smart trousers may be worn at any time.</p> <p>Smart denims are acceptable as long as they are clean and presentable.</p> <p><i>No torn clothing or work overalls are allowed.</i></p>
<b>SHORTS/SKIRTS &amp; SOCKS</b>	<b>SHORTS/SKIRTS &amp; SOCKS</b>
<p><i>Gentlemen - Shorts must be tailored and designed for golf.</i></p> <p><i>Cargo Shorts are not permitted</i></p> <p>“Loose-fitting casual trousers with large flap pockets on the thighs, which are sown onto the outside of the shorts”</p> <p><i>Ladies - Shorts/Skirts must be tailored and designed for golf.</i></p> <p><i>Socks - Short sport socks (white or coloured to co-ordinate with clothing)) must be worn at all times and must be visible.</i></p> <p><i>Beach type, sports (football, rugby, athletic etc) shorts are NOT permitted.</i></p>	<p>Smart shorts / skirts</p> <p><i>Cargo Shorts are not permitted</i></p> <p>“Loose-fitting casual trousers with large flap pockets on the thighs, which are sown onto the outside of the shorts”</p> <p><i>Socks</i> do not have to be worn if that is preferred.</p> <p><i>Beach type, sports (football, rugby, athletic etc) shorts are NOT permitted.</i></p>
<b>FOOTWEAR</b>	<b>FOOTWEAR</b>
<p><i>Gentlemen / Ladies</i></p> <p>Golf shoes must be worn at all times.</p>	<p>Leisure, deck and sandal style footwear are allowed</p> <p><i>“FLIP-FLOPS” are not allowed</i></p> <p>“A backless, often foam rubber sandal, held to the foot at the big toe by means of a thong”.</p> <p><i>Golf shoes may only be worn in the 19<sup>th</sup>.</i></p> <p><i>“CROCS” are not permitted</i></p>
<p><b>The Management, Captain, General Manager and Committee Members of Knighton Heath Golf Club have full authority to use their discretion in enforcing this dress code.</b></p> <p><b>Members and guests/visitors are requested and expected to adhere at all times to this code.</b></p>	<p><b>Mobile phones, message devices and laptops</b></p> <p>*All devices must be on silent in all areas at all times.</p> <p>*Mobile phones may only be used (call answering) in the lobby area and the locker rooms of the clubhouse.</p> <p>Their use is not permitted elsewhere in the Clubhouse, on the patio or particularly on the Course (except in extreme emergency conditions).</p> <p>*Laptops and other devices may be operated in the 19<sup>th</sup> only.</p>
