



Ditch clearance continuing on the 12th hole

The greenkeepers cannot get a haircut at the moment but the hedge at the 18th can get a short back and sides.



Sanding and then applying teak oil to course benches.

More scrub work back left for the 12th green.



Much needed drainage on the 9th tee (100m of new drainage)



The 8th path leading up to the tee was also edged

Raised the area covering the exposed roots at the start of the greenside path on the 13th and turfed.



Log edge along the side of the 12th path. The bank has been cleaned to encourage natural heather regeneration.



Daily greens maintenance.

1. remove dew to reduce risk of disease.
2. switch worm casts.
3. blow to remove any debris from the surface. This is done daily Monday to Sunday to keep the greens in good condition ready for the return of golf.
