2. What is being proposed?


- An indoor practice area that may Include the following elements:
- practice net(s) and putting area
- indoor teaching facility using modern flight tracking computer software and graphics
- simulated play screen multiple course with computer generated graphics
- Enhanced pro shop services (see PAGE 10)
- Possible future Indoor competitions

3. What are the building options?

- The KHGC Management are currently considering two options:
- Option 1 Bespoke building built by a company specialising in this type of construction
- Option 2 Wooden Cabin same size as Bespoke option but of differing construction materials.

4. What will it look like externally?

The following gives you an idea of a side elevation

5. What will the inside look like?

- The following gives some idea of what a computer simulated practice area might look like
- Refer to the brochure for more details



6. Where will it be located?

- The Management committee of KHGC propose that the facility will be located in or around the current practice area to the rear of the clubhouse.
- The exact location is yet to be finalised and may depend on plans to redevelop the practice area and patio area.

7. How much will it cost?

- The latest projected costs for this project are:
- Structure to include build and 'basic' fitting out with power and heating etc
 - Bespoke £40k Wooden cabin £18k
- Fitting out to include practice nets and computers £25k - £35k
- Total estimated cost £43k £75k

Cost will vary according to structure and fitting out

8. Who will pay the costs involved?

- It is hoped that the initial costs of the project will be funded mainly via grants ie Sport England, Lottery etc
- However it is possible that contributions may be sought from :
- Corporate and/or personal sponsors
- Bank loans
- KHGC membership fees specific allocated amount Please refer to Question 11 on the survey to give your opinion on how we should fund the project.

9. How much will it cost me to use the facility?

At this stage it is proposed that the following

10. What else might we get from the new facility?

Improved Professional services re:

- * Club fitting
- * Ball fitting
- * Club gap analysis

As a club we may also be able to provide:

* New internal competitions during the winter using computer generated graphics.

Many of these services will depend on what level of fitting out we choose to undertake.

11. When will the facility be built?

- This is very difficult to determine given the various sources of funding that might be used.
- The best case scenarios are :

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Fully funded via grants – 2 years
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PLUS /OR

Grants & sponsorship -2-4 years

PLUS / OR

Elements inc KHGC funds – 5 years +

12. Summary of benefits

- Extended practice season to inc winter
- Practice in comfort during the winter or periods of heavy rain etc
- New practice area adjacent to putting green
- Enhanced professional services
- Possible new club competitions via the computer generated graphics screen

 NB without professional tuition
- Q8 the maximum would pay for each element
- NB with professional tuition
- Q10 how often you might have lessons in future
- Q11 possible sources of funding
- Q12 Where the project ranks along with other proposed work at the club.

16. What if?

- I don't like the idea of the project
- I will never plan to use all or some of the facilities planned
- I think that there are far better things to spend funds on
- Other projects should have priority over this project

The survey has specific answers that should cover all the above – please make sure you give us your honest feedback to the questions asked. They will form an important part in our decision process.

17. What happens next?

- On completion of the survey :
 - results will be collated and analysed
 - the membership will receive feedback
 - management will propose the next step
 - **GO** continue with project
 - **HOLD** defer all or part of the project
 - NO GO discontinue with project
- the membership will be asked to respond to the management proposals
 - a final decision will be taken
