- In order to avoid possible issues and ensure the best possible experience for all competitors it is vital to keep the field together (no big gaps) and to start as early as possible to ensure maximum flexibility in the event of weather or other delays in play.
- The PGA Tournament Director will be responsible for any decisions over whether the course / conditions are fit for play.
- For information, PGA Tournament regulations are as follows (6b 5.4):
  - a) As a fundamental principle the Tournament Director shall adopt the policy which offers the most likely opportunity to complete the tournament over the number of holes stipulated in the conditions of for the tournament.
  - i) Pro-Am prize money allocated for Professional Team and Individual prizes may be declared on the maximum number of holes completed by all professionals
  - j) In the event of the curtailment or cancellation of play, tournament prize money shall be distributed as agreed between the sponsors and the association and may vary from that published in the tournament conditions. However if bad weather causes the abandonment of a one day Pro-Am after all teams have commenced play, the result shall be declared over a minimum of 6/9 (TBC) holes completed by all teams; and
  - k) The Tournament Director may authorise the re-siting of a hole or holes if the course becomes waterlogged during play.



### FIELD DEVELOPMENT

Invitations may be extended to the following: Up to 10% of the total field from outside the PGA in England & Wales (South West) area.

Please make the Director aware of any invited / requested PGA Professionals. Please note Professionals must be either current PGA Members or Members of a recognised International Tour.

Please forward a suggested start sheet to your Tournament Director 2 weeks before the event. The closing date for PGA Professionals is 2 weeks prior to the tournament.
