

# Knighton Heath Golf Club

## Local Rules 2012

#### 1. Out of Bounds

A ball is out of bounds if it lies outside the boundary of the Course (The Clubhouse area including car parks, paths, putting green, chipping green and garden and greenkeepers' area between 7<sup>th</sup> tee and 10<sup>th</sup> green are not part of the Course).

2. Pylons, Water Value Covers, Railings and Protective Netting, 150yard Markers are immovable obstructions (Rule 24-2)

### 3. Fixed Sprinkler Heads are Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24-2)

In addition, if such an obstruction on or within two club lengths of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief, without penalty, as follows; If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which (a) is not nearer the hole (b) avoids such intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

#### 4. Paths and Roads

Relief is given from those surfaced with limestone, astroturf or tarmac. Fencing immediately adjacent and running parallel to these paths is an integral part of these paths (Rule 24-2).

- **5.** (a) Overhead Wires a ball striking these must be replayed without penalty.
  - **(b) Ditches** relief is given from those running parallel to the road at the 18<sup>th</sup> hole (Rule 24-2)
- **6. Stones in Bunkers** are movable obstructions (Rule 24-2).
- 7. Relief may be taken from aeration holes and from machinery ruts.
- 8. Relief must be taken from all areas of G.U.R and from all staked trees.

### 9. Breach of Local Rule

Penalty: Match Play – Loss of Hole Stroke Play – Two Strokes
