THE TRAFFIC LIGHT SYSTEM

GREEN

No Restrictions

AMBER

Full course available to all, however those using a trolley or buggy must use the 90 degree rule (Trolleys or buggies must STAY in the rough and use paths where provided)

RED

Full course available to those who can carry a bag.

Those who need to use a trolley/buggy, holes 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 10th and 11th, are available for play using the 90 degree rule, you must follow the directional signage and pathways where provided.

BOOKING TIMES

The Captains committee have approved reducing tee booking times to 8 minute intervals in an effort to ensure as many players as possible can play during the shorter daylight hours of winter.

I must remind you of your responsibility to socially distance whilst on the course and to show respect to all groups on the course.

COMPETITION DIVISIONS

Following the introduction of the World Handicap System we feel that it is time to look at the balance of our divisions in singles strokeplay and stableford formats. To achieve this the first singles competition next year will have the divisions set 2 or 3 days before the competition to give as even a balance as is possible. There is no way to create a perfect split but we will attempt to get as close as possible
