Course Projects



The Club Management has made a bold move and is currently investigating replacing and upgrading the course water supply, storage and on course irrigation system.

The current system is over 40 years old and will soon reach the end of its life with ageing electrical and mechanical equipment resulting in lack of water pressure and pipe work leaks.

A specialist sports fields irrigation consultant, Irritech has been appointed to assist with the designs and to oversee the project.

This work will be done in phases:

Phase 1 - drilling of a bore hole approx 60 metres deep to install equipment, which will extract ground water to supply the current tank, which is fed by the expensive mains supply.

We have obtained competitive tenders and have placed an order with the successful bidder. This work was due to be completed in Q1 2021, but due to COVID restrictions has been delayed and we now hope to have it completed within Q2 2021.

Phase 2 - will run in parallel with phase 1, design proposals for a suitable and affordable course irrigation system has been commenced and will go to tender very soon.

As phase 2 has huge financial implications on the club, an EGM will be held at the appropriate time, for members to decide if the project should move ahead.

All the facts and figures will be tabled at the meeting.

Further updates on this will be reported to members as the project develops.

Its mission is to safeguard the welfare of children and young people, as well as adults at risk, in the sport of golf.

SafeGolf is firstly, a website – www.safegolf.org – through which anyone with a concern about the welfare of a player, or the behaviour or practice of a coach, volunteer, organiser, parent or a player, can contact the lead safeguarding officer at their national governing body.

Secondly, it is the safeguarding standard England Golf will promote to all their affiliated clubs to ensure all clubs provide a safe and positive experience to children and young people whilst playing golf.

The PGA are also using the standards to apply to all their PGA professional Coaches.
