NHS Track & Trace



From Thursday 24 September 2020, the club will display an official NHS QR code poster at the entrances and at the bar. It's quick and simple to use and enables members and visitors to scan the NHS QR code when they arrive by using the NHS COVID-19 app.

The NHS COVID-19 app has a feature that allows users to quickly and easily 'check in' to your venue by scanning the code. The information stays on the user's phone. In England, you do not have to ask people who choose to 'check in' using the official NHS QR code to provide their contact details. If there is an outbreak associated with a venue, a message will be sent to the relevant app users with the necessary public health advice.

This will help to avoid the reintroduction of lockdown measures and support the country to return to, and maintain, a more normal way of life.

If you do not have a smartphone or the NHS COVID-19 app to provide your contact details, your members (bar) card will also ensure your details are stored when making a purchase at the bar.

It is each members responsibility to ensure that their guests either scan in the QR code or furnish their details to the bar staff on duty.

General

Course Maintenance Week



Monday 5 - Friday 9 October 2020:

The green staff will be carrying out the following essential work during the above week: .

- * Verti drain with 13mm diameter tines 200mm deep to relive compaction
- * Application of NutriZorb to improve the soil structure and texture
- * Top dressing to improve soil structure and texture
- * Over seeding with bent grass to improve the sward
- * An application of a granular fertilizer.

While this work is taking place temporary greens will be in operation, which will allow the green staff to get the greens back into play as soon as possible.
