BALL CHUTE / BOOKING SYSTEM



The Captains Committee has decided to implement the hybrid system as recommended by England Golf relating to the 'Turn up and Play (Ball Chute) and bookable" options.

- * The new booking system will commence from **Monday 9 August 2021 at 20:00.**
- * Members will be able to book 3 weeks in advance.
- * Tee times will remain at 10 minute intervals.

Ball Chute players overlapping with the bookable tee times

- * Members who turn up and realise that they will not get out before the bookable times commence will need to remove their ball from the ball chute and ask at the Pro Shop to look to see if there are any gaps available in the bookable slots.
- * Members must ensure that they do check the website calendar as other events such as competitions, ladies and seniors representative matches, societies etc. do commence and take place during the 'Ball Chute' times and therefore, members would not be able to play if the tee has been allocated for a match/event.
