

KNIGHTON HEATH GOLF CLUB ROLLING IMPROVEMENT PLAN

INTRODUCTION

This document has been produced by the Greens committee to identify the main projects to improve the course as a rolling plan.

The proposals cover all aspects of the course and should be read in conjunction with the Forestry Plan.

Each year we will select the main priorities from this document and submit them to the KHGC Management committee for approval or revision as part of the annual budget. If financial constraints are encountered in a given year part or the entire budget could be withdrawn in which case the projects will be carried forward to the next year.

Greens

- Drain the 8th green
- Drain the 7th green
- Drain the 17th green

Tees

- 2nd Tee, to increase the size so that the plate is usable
- 3rd Tee, to increase the size so that the plate is usable
- 3rd Tee, to level and re-orientate.
- 7th Tee, to level and increase the playing area.
- 10th Medal tee, to level
- 10th Medal tee, to increase the size so that the plate is usable
- 13th Tee, to level and increase the playing area if possible.
- 11th Tee, to increase the size so that the plate is usable
- 12th Tee, to level and reshape, increasing the playing area.

Bunkers

- 4th Right hand bunker, to reshape.
- 6th Bunker, to drain and reshape.
- 11th Left hand bunker, to reshape.
- 12th Right and left hand bunker, to reshape.
- 16th Approach bunker, to reshape and line to stop stones from coming up.
- 16th Fairway bunker, to reshape and line to stop stones from coming up.

Pathways

- 4th Tee path to the 4th fairway including path from the 3rd hole
- 7th Tee path, to install a new path from the 6th green to the 7th tee.
- 12th Tee path, to replace existing path with limestone.
- 14th Tee to the 15th Tee
- 14th trolley park near to green
- 16th Green path to the 17th Tee
- 18th Path, to replace existing path with limestone.

Worn areas

Examples

Walk off area right of the 8th green. Right of the 4th Tee by the trees. Walk off area by the 7th green.

Drainage

- 3rd Carry, to improve the all year playability.
- 3rd Green, to drain the back left area.
- 4th Green, to drain the front part of the green.
- 4th Fairway, to drain the flat area.
- 7th Green, to drain front part of the green.
- 8th Approach, to re-drain stopping the water reaching the green.
- 9th Tee, drain the whole area.
- 10th Approach, to drain the whole area.

- 10th Fairway, to drain the area in front of the fairway bunker.
- 10th Rough, to drain the areas that always holds water.
- 11th Green, to drain the front half of the green.
- 12th Approach, to drain the whole approach.
- 13th Fairway, to drain left side of the fairway.
- 15th Green, a new drain to cut off water reaching the green.
- 16th Tee, drain the whole tee.
- 17th Approach, to drain the whole area.

Ditches

- 1st Left side in the rough by the trees
- 3rd in the carry and along tree line on the left
- 4th left side in the rough by the trees
- 8th in the carry
- 10th right side in the rough
- 12th ditch by tee and all the way to the 13th hole. The area from the bridge on 12th to the 13th outlet completed.
- 15th left side along the tree line

Practice facilities

- Bunker at chipping green
- Practice tee.

Major projects

- Ground water extraction. To install a bore hole and equipment to feed the existing water tank
- Course irrigation system. To replace the 40 year old irrigation system.
- Course re-designs, to eliminate the over the road tee shot on the 18th hole.
