Item

Welcome and apologies

- 1 DP welcomed all committee members. There were apologies from Bill Kennedy and Ted Coates.

- 2 Minutes of previous meeting (9<sup>th</sup> April 2013)

It was agreed the minutes were a true record of the previous meeting and were signed by the Captain.

- 3 Matters Arising

With regard to pre match coffee this was now provided by the catering staff for both teams, i.e. 24 cups and paid for by the Senior's Section. The Captain of the Day must obtain an invoice from Trish and present this to GD for payment.

The committee also approved the sum of £282.77p to be paid by the Senior's Treasurer for the purchase of a Refreshment Tent for KHGC as a gesture of good will.

12 Any Other Business


