

## USE OF A GOLF BUGGY

To comply with EGU competition rules, it shall be a condition of any club qualifying competition that players must walk at all times during a stipulated round, unless permitted to use a golf buggy.

A golf buggy may only be used by a player who can provide a valid current medical certificate of disability.

If any member, including blue badge holders, consider they need a buggy to play during qualifying competitions, please ask your doctor to complete the following MEDICAL FORM.
